

Comics Plus FAQs for Library Staff

What is Comics Plus? Comics Plus is a digital platform offering access to thousands of digital comics, graphic novels, and manga. It is exclusively available through your public libraries. The platform is powered by LibraryPass™

How do Library members Access Comics Plus?



Initial Account Setup: New users must create an account using their library card number and pin.



Website Access: Members can find Comics Plus on the library's website



Login: Once they locate the platform, borrowers will need to search for the library name and enter their login credentials.



Browsing: Once logged in, users can browse the collection or search for specific titles.



Reading: To read a title, users can hover or tap on the cover and click/tap "Read Now" or "Add to My Shelf".



Enjoying: After selecting their titles, borrowers can start reading.

When is Comics Plus Available? Comics Plus is available 24/7 for both online and offline reading. An internet connection is needed to browse the collection and check out titles. However, downloaded titles can be accessed offline via the LibraryPass app.

How Can Library members Find Comics to Read? Users can find titles by:



Browsing curated lists on the homepage.



Browsing by category, publisher, or age level.



Using the search box to look for specific titles and keywords.

Are There Holds on Comics Plus Titles? No, there are no holds. All titles are available for unlimited, simultaneous access. This means multiple users can read the same comic at the same time.

Does the Comics Plus Collection Change? Yes, new titles are regularly added to the collection. Library users can find these latest additions in the "Just Added" section of the library's collection.

How Does Comics Plus Handle User Privacy? Comics Plus takes privacy very seriously. User account information, browsing activity, and borrowing history are kept private. More details can be found in their privacy policy.

How to Show a Member of the Public Where to Find Comics Plus:

1.

Library Website: Guide the user to the library's website.

2.

Locate Comics Plus: Point out where the Comics Plus link or icon is located on the site. It might be in a digital resources section or on the main page.

3.

Login: Explain to the member that they may have to log in to their library account first.

4.

Platform Options: Explain to the user they can also access Comics Plus via the LibraryPass app, which they can download to their iOS or Android devices.

5.

Assistance: If the borrower is still unsure or needs additional help, library staff can assist them further or direct them to the help resources within Comics Plus for more information.
